



### Electrical Service for Festival Vendors

All vendors will be provided one 20 amp, 120 volt circuit (Edison Plug) as a part of their basic site fee. Any additional electrical service will carry with it an additional fee in accordance with the fee schedule below. Additional service must be ordered and paid for in advance. Fill out the form below and include it with your application. All electrical service connections will be provided to within 40 feet of the vendor space.

Vendors are responsible for providing their own power cords and power distribution from the service connection to and within their vending space. A 20 amp, 120 volt circuit (Edison Plug) requires a 12 gauge power cord. A 30 amp service requires 10 gauge wire and a 50 amp service requires 6 gauge wire. Use of 14 or 16 gauge cords is not acceptable.

For service requiring other than 20 amp, 120 volt circuit (Edison Plug) specify the style of connector you are using by NEMA number or similar designation or with the exact writing on the plug and cable. See examples below.

If you have different specs and require the use of a WHISPER/LOW EXHAUST Generator, there is a \$35 convenience fee to use your own generator. We have limited available spaces for generator use in the Original. They will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Your generator must register under 65DBs at 20ft or less, and have little to no exhaust output.
